- 1. Go to the Google Account sign in page.
- 2. Click Create account.
- 3. Enter your name.
- 4. In the "Username" field, enter a username.
- 5. Enter and confirm your password. (Tip: When you enter your password on mobile, the first letter isn't case

sensitive).

- 6. Click Next. (Optional: Add and verify a phone number for your account).
- 7. Click Next.

Use an existing email address

- 1. Go to the Google Account Sign In page.
- 2. Click Create account.
- 3. Enter your name.
- 4. Click Use my current email address instead.
- 5. Enter your current email address.
- 6. Click Next.
- 7. Verify your email address with the code sent to your existing email.
- 8. Click Verify.
